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Medical care

All residents have an individualized care plan and care team.

Each resident's personal physician is part of the care team. On-site physician visits are encouraged.

Care plans are assessed routinely so that changes in care and social activities are made for each phase of the disease.

Family members participate in the planning of care for their loved one.
